EXCEPTIONAL MILESTONES !!!!

- The Gregorians of Kottarakara once again outshines in the CBSE class X & XII Board Examination 2025. In Class X, 96 students appeared for the Examination and 71 students secured distinction and 25 students secured first class.

And in Class XII, out of 108 students, 80 students bagged distinction and 28 students secured First Class.

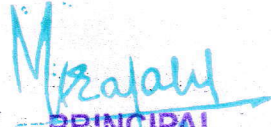
