We are thrilled to announce that MGM Education, Kerala's Largest educational institution has successfully acquired 2 more schools in Kerala, Holy Angels Model School in Pathanamthitta and Nehru Memorial Public School, Kollam.

The academic year began on 5th June 2024. We have a student strength of 987 and are blessed with highly dedicated 45 members of teaching staff and 23 non-teaching staff.

Academic achievements

Our students participated in many competitive examinations like Science Olympiad foundation for Science, Maths and English, Vidya Darshan talent examination and Kerala GK Quiz competition conducted by Federal Bank in collaboration with H & C Books.

Master Arav Shiju of class II B has set immensive records including entries in India book of records, Kalam's World Records and more highlighting his remarkable achievements for the fastest reciting of 44 Kerala rivers names in the least time of 42 seconds.

Sports & Games

In the field of sports and games also, we are no way behind. Our Annual sports meet was conducted on 22nd November 2024. The Chief Guest was Mr. Avinash Kumar A, Athletics coach at Kerala Sports Council. Students participated in the events representing four houses. Taxilla house were the winners and Nalanda house were the runners up. Kollam District Sahodaya Athletic Championship was conducted on 2nd January 2024. Our school secured 7 gold medals, 3 silver medals and 2 bronze medals. We were also the overall champions in Under 12 category. Our sub junior Boys bagged bronze medal in Kollam District Kho Kho championship. Sreenandha of VI C, Rudra of VIII B, Ishitha of VIII B, Karthik A D of VII B, Daivik of class VIII B and Aswin U N of class VI A were selected for Kho Kho state championship at Kannur. Parvathy Raj of class V B received Gold medal in sub junior girls squay martial art championship. Aami S of class I A won Gold medal in Kollam District Squay championship. Durga L Pillai of class III A secured Gold medal in sub junior girls (Kaushal) and Silver medal in sub junior girls (Yudham) in State Sqay Martial Art championship. Rithvik Sanand of class III C received first prize in Kattha in 7 years. Jubin B of class V B received God Medal in District Kumite Championship. Abhav M Pillai of class VIII B represented Kerala and got Bronze medal in Roll Ball National Championship, South zone held at Chennai, representing Kerala. Nirved Vinay Kurup of class III C got Gold Medal in National Katha championship. Yadunandhan of class IV B got Silver Medal in District Kumite Championship.
