J U D G M E N T

Aggrieved by the inaction on the part of the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent in granting affiliation to the petitioner, the petitioner has come up before this Court.

2. The petitioner school alleges that the same is following CBSE syllabus. In order to get affiliation from the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent, NOC has to be obtained from the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent. Therefore, the petitioner submitted an application along with challan before the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent, who refused to grant NOC due to the existence of Ext.P5 Government Order, wherein the Government has decided to grant NOC to the schools situated in five northern districts of Kerala. The petitioner alleges that this Court, as per Ext.P6 judgment, quashed Ext.P5 G.O. and; though the Government has filed appeal against Ext.P6 judgment, the Division Bench did not interfere with Ext.P6, but
