ANNUAL REPORT 2019- 20

I am much excited to address you all on this auspicious occasion- MGM FIESTA 2020. With your blessing let me present before you a summary of the current academic session.

Mar Gregorios Memorial group of schools is an educational initiative of Mr Gee varghese Yohannan, established in the memory of late Yohannan Geevarghese, the illustrious founder. MGM Group of schools is named after the patron saint Mar Gregorios of Parumala. Vidya Mount Public school has become a part of this prestigious institution in June 2015.
