SCHOOL ANNUAL REPORT 2019 – 2020

On the occasion of the 12th Annual Day of Ponmudi Valley Public School, Vithura, I am honoured to present the School Annual Report for the academic year 2019 – 2020.

The school academic session commenced on 6thJune 2019. Presently the school has 430 Students, 27 Teachers and 20 Non - Teaching Staff. The academic staff began their pursuit for improvement by attending a full day Orientation Programme conducted by Dr. Jesudas Jeyapaul on 30 May 2019.

The School organized the Environment Day. The District Forest Department joined hands with this endeavour by providing 400 saplings of fruit yielding plants. Each student was given a sapling to be planted in their home environment as a part of 'Plant a Sapling Programme'.

Events like Reading Day, Yoga Day, Patron's Day, Children's Day etc. were organized by the school. The students entertained the staff by arranging recreational games and 'cultural programmes.'

As a prelude of the Investiture Ceremony, the school conducted election to choose the student leaders. The students cast their votes in ballot boxes and elected their Head Boy, Head Girl and School Appointments.

On the occasion of Gandhi Jayanthi, the students conducted a cleaning campaign of the school premises and class rooms as a part of Swatchch Bharat Abhiyan.

Festivals like Eid-ul Fitr, Onam and Christmas were organized by the school, with a lot of gaiety and fervour. On the occasion of Christmas, the students and staff raised funds and provided lunch to the inpatients of Govt. Taluk Hospital, Vithura. They visited the hospital and distributed the lunch packets.

In order to encourage the students to develop their literary and artistic skills, the school organized Swaralaya 2019, the Arts Fest. Swara Laya provided a golden opportunity for all the students to exhibit their talents on a common school platform.

Ms Bhadra Santhosh won the 2nd prize in the Savvy Hunt 2019, the inter school competition held at Kottarakara. Our students won championship in the primary, upper primary and high school categories in the Thiruvananthapuram District Kofukan Karate Competition for Schools. The School was the Overall Winners in this prestigious competition for the 6th time in a row.

Ms. Arundhathy Sumesh of UKG B presented a poem on Kavya Dalangal, telecast by Media Plus Channel.

The Fest, organised by the school, provided a big platform for the students to exhibit their creative skills. Every class put up the creative works in a class wise exhibition. Vegetable Carving and Wealth from the Waste Competitions were organized for the parents.

Competitions in Football, Throw Ball, Cricket and Athletics were held in connection with the Sports Meet.

In the Satyan Smaraka Inter School Arts & Literary Competition held for the schools in Thiruvananthapuram, our students won several individual prizes.

The Kindergarten section organized several events like Yellow and Mango Day, Pink Day and Butterfly Day.

They also visited the Post Office for a Field Trip on the Indian Postal Day and posted letters to their parents.
